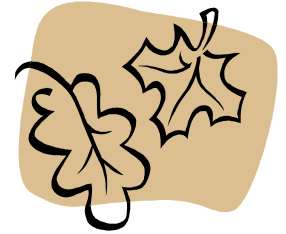




Kirkhill Nursery Newsletter
